Dear Neighbours

The Brettenham House Project has now advanced to the stage of finalising its internal design finishes. The internal finishes will incorporate Sustainable Timbers such as Oak and Ash, nationally sourced Portland stone to match the heritage and character of Westminster and finally Exotic stone being sourced from Italy - such as green natural marble for both flooring and wall cladding. Concurrently offsite nurseries in Kent are cultivating and caring for the plants that will soon be placed on the landscaped terraces, thereby achieving a design that adheres to high environmental standards.
